2011 Wisconsin Volleyball Conference Women's Playdate #1 Tournament Format Saturday, February 5 UW-La Crosse

1 pool of 4 teams and 1 pool of 5 teams will play standard Pool Play format against teams in your pool. Note the schedule, as Pool A (5 teams) will play on two courts (1 and 3). All teams are guaranteed 5 matches including playoffs.

- All pool play and playoff matches are best 2 of 3 games to 25, with game three to 15. No point cap in any games. Game three is played only if it is a 2. deciding game.
- Start times are used for scheduling only matches will take place after the previous match is concluded on that court. The first round of playoffs will 3. begin at the same time on both courts, and then matches will run continue taking place after the previous match is concluded, with the start times being for scheduling purposes only. It will be a long day, so it is important that the work crews keep the courts moving and teams are ready to play when the previous match ends.
- Pool Rounds 1-2 and Playoffs: 10 minutes suggested 3 min ball handling, 6 min shared hitting, 1 min serving 4. Warm-ups: Pool Rounds 3-6 (Playoff option if both teams agree): 6 minutes – suggested 5 min shared hitting, 1 min serving
- 5. Officiating - Teams must provide an R1, R2, 2 line judges, and 2 scorekeepers for all pool play matches, R1's will be provided for all playoff matches, however teams still need to provide an R2, 2 line judges, and 2 scorekeepers for all playoff matches except the Championship Match.

Note that teams in Rounds 2, 3 and 5 will share officiating duties on Court 3. During the captain's meeting, please confirm that the teams combining crews have enough players to make this work, and if not, the tournament directors may ask a player from another team not playing or officiating to assist.

Teams will be asked to officiate on the court after losing your final match of playoffs. It is important that you fulfill all officiating responsibilities, as this may impact your participation in the second playdate and the State Championships. If La Crosse is NOT playing in the championship match, they will provide the officiating crew for that match.

6. After the completion of Pool Play, all teams are pre-seeded into the Championship Playoffs based on where they finish in their respective pools. Refer to the playoff brackets for seedings. The following tiebreaking criteria will be used after pool play:

- (a) Overall Match Record
- (b) Head to Head Match Record
- (c) Game Percentage (games won/total games played)
- (d) Point Percentage (points scored/points opponents scored)

7. Pursuit rule is not in effect. Libero serving and 12 Substitutions will be used.

8. Refer to http://ncvfvolleyball.org/RulesofPlay.aspx for uniform rules. Shorts must be similar but do not need to be identical.

9. An individual from the Championship Team will be named the Most Outstanding Player for the tournament, and will receive their award at the State Championships Tournament in April.

10. Statistics - As agreed upon at the Kickoff Meeting, teams will be required to take statistics during all Playdate matches. These statistics should be collected and compiled by the following weekend, and posted on your teams website.

11. Player of the Week - The Most Outstanding Player for the tournament will be recognized as one of our players of the week, but we would like to recognize several players from the playdate, so if you have a player that really brings it on Saturday, please send her stats (even just kills and digs) to Lumpy at lumpyyb@hotmail.com so she can be recognized for her efforts.
