4. **Trainers** – Laura Hudson will be at Mitchell Hall during the tournament, please provide your own tape.

5. **Officials** – Thanks for helping us out this weekend, and to Julie Voeck, WVC Official's Assignor for scheduling officials for this weekend's tournament.

6. **Volleyballs** – Teams are responsible for their own warm-up volleyball, and to provide **one game ball per match**. UWL will attempt to provide one game ball per court. Only **Molten** volleyballs may be used for game balls. (Women's preferred, Men's acceptable)



7. **Scoresheets** – Work crews should leave completed scoresheets in the binders - the tournament directors will pick them up and record scores.

8. **Concessions** – Soda, water, Gatorade, subs, hot dogs, chips, candy and baked goods will be available throughout the tournament, and is also a fundraiser for UW-La Crosse. Please support their efforts!

9. **Playdate #3 Most Outstanding Player** – An individual will be selected from the **Tournament Championship Team** and recognized for their efforts. They will receive their award at the State Championships Tournament in April. Congratulations to UW-Green Bay's Keri Klotzbuecher (#7) for being selected the Most Outstanding Player last weekend in Oshkosh.

12. **Oshkosh A & B, Eau Claire A & B and Whitewater A & B Rosters** – Will be submitted to the tournament director at the Captain's Meeting, and players from each team may not switch teams for any reason during the tournament. These rosters will be made available to the officials if necessary. These rosters will then remain as submitted for the remainder of the 2012 WVC season including the WVC State Championships Tournament, unless formally appealed through the WVC Advisory Committee.

13. **Statistics** – As agreed upon at the Kickoff Meeting, teams will be required to take statistics during all Playdate matches. These statistics should be collected and compiled by the following weekend, and posted on your teams website.

Saturday, March 3 UW-La Crosse

1. **Pool Play** - 3 pools of 4-teams will play standard Pool Play format against teams in your pool. All teams are guaranteed 5 matches including playoffs.

2. **All pool play matches are 2 games to 25, with no point cap in any games.**
3. **Start times are used for scheduling only** – Matches will take place after the previous match is concluded on that court.
4. **Warm-ups:** Pool Rounds 1-2: 10 minutes – suggested 3 min ball handling, 6 min shared hitting, 1 min serving

Pool Rounds 3-6 & Playoffs: 6 minutes – suggested 5 min shared hitting, 1 min serving



Important Note – At the conclusion of each pool play match, the officiating team for the next match should call captains within 5 minutes of the previous match completion. We need to do everything we can to keep the day moving along, and most time is lost between matches and during warm-ups – please help out by being to your court in a timely manner!

5. **Officiating** - Teams must provide an R1, R2, 2 line judges, and 2 scorekeepers for all pool play matches.
- R1's will be provided for all playoff matches, however teams still need to provide an R2, 2 line judges, and 2 scorekeepers for all playoff matches except the Championship Matches.

Teams will be asked to officiate on the court after losing your final match of playoffs. It is important that you fulfill all officiating responsibilities, as this may impact your participation in the State Championships. If **La Crosse** is NOT playing in the championship match, they will provide the officiating crews for the Championship Matches.

6. **Playoffs** - After the completion of Pool Play, all teams are **pre-seeded** into the Championship Playoffs based on where they finish in their respective pools. All **playoff matches are 2 of 3 games to 25, with game three to 15. No point cap in any games.** Game three is played only if it is a deciding game. Refer to the playoff brackets for seedings. The following tiebreaking criteria will be used after pool play:

- (a) Head to Head games
- (b) Head to Head point differential
- (c) Total point differential
- (d) Coin Flip

7. The first round of playoffs will begin at the same time on all four courts. Then, matches will continue after the previous match is concluded, with the start times being used for scheduling purposes only.

9. Pursuit rule is not in effect. Libero serving and 12 Substitutions will be used.
