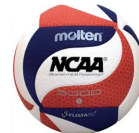


Men's Tournament #2 - February 12, 2022 @ Greenheck Field House

Check-in @ 8:00 AM - Play begins at 8:30 AM

- 1. Tournament Venue** – [Greenheck Field House](#), 6400 Alderson Street Weston, WI 54476 (Attached to D.C. Everest High School)
- 2. Parking, Lockers and Facilities Usage:** When heading south on Alderson Street, Greenheck Field House will be on your right, next to D.C. Everest High School. This north entrance can be used to enter the facility. You can park anywhere in this lot. You will enter through the main doors, proceed past that cafeteria area, and the gym is to your left. Public locker rooms are open for us to use.
- 3. Volleyballs** – Teams are responsible for their own warm-up volleyballs, and to provide **one game ball per match**. Only **Molten** volleyballs may be used for game balls.
- 4. Scoresheets** – Officials will bring completed score sheets to the designated tournament location.
- 5. Concessions** – Concessions will be available through Greenheck's concession stand in the main lobby after 9am. There are several delivery options nearby as well (such as Jimmy John's) or several options 5 minutes away or less. These options include: McDonalds, Burger King, Taco John's, Subway, Wendy's, Pizza Hut, among others.
- 6. Team Rosters** – Are set from the first play date, and will then remain as submitted for the remainder of the 2022 WVC season including the WVC Championships Tournament, unless formally appealed through the WVC Advisory Committee. **The WVC Tournament Director will verify team rosters with ID's prior to the match beginning.**

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

1. Start times are used for scheduling only as matches will take place after the previous match is concluded on that court.
- 2. Matches are best 2 of 3 sets.**
- 3. Warm-ups** will be 2-4-4 for the first matches of the day (2 min. shared ball handling, then 4 min. individual court time to attack and serve). All warm-ups after that will be 3-3.
- 4. Officiating:** Teams will be asked to provide a R2, 2 line judges, book, libero, and score keeper. An R1 official will be provided on one court so two courts will require teams to provide an R1. **Please bring whistles! PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE IF YOU NEED TO REF!!**
- 5. COVID-19 Protocol:** Spectators are allowed. Masks are recommended but not required.

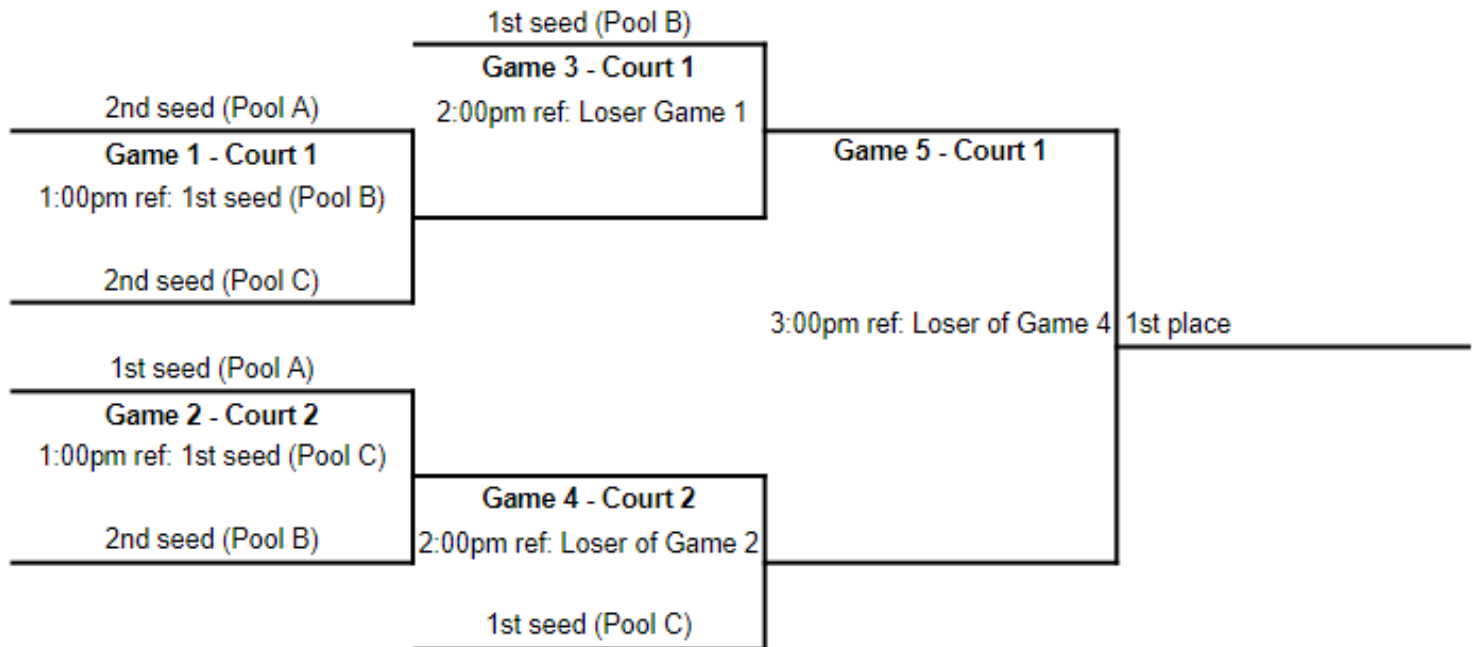

Pool Play/Bracket Format

- Pool play will be best 2 of 3. The first two will be played to 25, the third if necessary will be played to 15 (Win by 2).
- Teams will compete in morning pool play and then be placed into an appropriate playoff match. All 1st and 2nd place teams will be placed into the championship bracket, and all 3rd and 4th place (for Pool C) teams will be placed into the consolation bracket.
- Seeding/tie breakers in pool play determined by:
 - Overall match record
 - Overall set record
 - Head to head game record
 - Overall point differential
 - Coin Flip
